ANTI-RAGGING CELL (ARC)

As per the order letter received w.e.f. 3311/VEC/2021 on Dt. 06/08/2021 the following ANTI-RAGGING CELL (ARC) has been reformed to perform the result oriented objectives and functions. This committee remains valid or in action till the further order from the Principal Office.

With vide letter of the University Grants Commission (UGC) No. F.1-16/2007 (CPP-II) dated June 17, 2009 as well as All India Council of Technical Education (AICTE) vide letter No. F.No.37-3/Legal/AICTE/2009 dated July, 07. 2009 has reiterated the ban on ragging of students in Institutions of Higher Learning. The students are therefore directed to strictly desist from any kind of ragging.

Forms of Ragging: Display of noisy, disorderly conduct, teasing, excitement by rough or rude treatment or handling, including rowdy, undisciplined activities which cause or likely to cause annoyance, undue hardship, physical or psychological harm or raise apprehensive fear in a fresher, or asking the students to do any act or perform something which such a student will not do in the ordinary course and which causes him/her shame or embarrassment or danger to his/her life, etc.

Punishment for Participation in/or Abetment of Ragging:

1. Cancellation of admission.
2. Suspension from attending classes.
3. Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
4. Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
5. Withholding results.
6. Debarring from representing the institution in any national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
7. Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
8. Rustication from the institution for periods varying from 1 to 4 semesters or equivalent period.
9. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution.

Affidavit by students and parents Each student and his/her parents/ guardian shall have to furnish an affidavit along with the application form to the effect that they will not participate in or abet the act of ragging and that, if found guilty, shall be liable for punishment under the penal law of India.
